In the hotel there are 15 twin rooms (2 single beds)

17 doubles 3 family 3 triples 9 singles

There are 2 larger double rooms (both with king-sized beds) at the front of the hotel. For these, there will be a supplement of £20.00 per room per night.

Bookings will be accepted on a 'first come' basis.

The hotel does not permit animals on premises.

A 'no-smoking' policy operates.

Fort William is surrounded by mountains and a deep sea loch, Loch Linnhe, is in front of the hotel. Behind the hotel is Ben Nevis, Britain's highest mountain, which dominates the skyline to the east.

Lochaber is an area of outstanding natural beauty. It includes a geopark with geotrails, there are earth heritage sites and the area is rich in history and culture. There is a modern leisure centre, an 18 hole golf course and, at Nevis Range, a mountain gondola.

Lochaber is a Gaelic Initiative Area with a dedicated development officer.
